

Amendment to August 12, 2003  
Memorandum of Understanding  
Between the  
United States Government Printing Office  
and the National Archives and Records Administration

The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) and the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) agree to revise the existing terms of agreement under the aegis of the GPO/NARA Memorandum of Understanding dated August 12, 2003.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Amendment is to modify the existing terms of agreement, which established an affiliate relationship between GPO and NARA for the content on *GPO Access*, GPO's publicly accessible Internet site. Implementation of the agreement eliminated potentially duplicative preservation activities at both GPO and NARA for that content. With this Amendment, the agreement will encompass the content in the Federal Digital System (FDsys), GPO's content management system for U.S. Government information in digital form which became GPO's official system of record in December 2010. GPO Access is now offline and its content has been successfully migrated to the FDsys.

**AMENDMENT**

The Scope section is replaced by:

This agreement encompasses the content (hereinafter referred to as "the records") in the Federal Digital System (FDsys), GPO's content management system for U.S. Government information in digital form.

All records subject to this agreement shall be additionally defined in Records Schedules to be established between NARA and the GPO. The records are designated as part of NARA Record Group 287, Publications of the U.S Government, Records of the Government Printing Office. This MOU provides for the deposit of the records outside the physical custody of NARA.

The phrase "GPO Access" in sections 12 and 14 of Actions is replaced by:


