Mr. FORBES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of the estate of Gail E. Dobert.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT.**

4 (a) PAYMENT AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of the
5 Treasury shall make a lump sum payment to the estate
6 of Gail E. Dobert (social security account number 082–
7 52–7101).

8 (b) AMOUNT OF PAYMENT.—The payment authorized
9 by subsection (a)—

10 (1) shall be equal to twice the gross annual pay
11 of Ms. Dobert at the time of her death;

1 (2) shall be payable out of amounts in the
2 Treasury not otherwise appropriated;

3 (3) shall not be subject to income taxes; and

4 (4) shall be in full satisfaction of all claims
5 against the United States in connection with the
6 death of Ms. Dobert.

7 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AGENT AND ATTORNEY FEES.**

8 Not more than a total of 10 percent of the payment
9 authorized by section 1 shall be paid to or received by any
10 agent or attorney for services rendered in connection with
11 obtaining such payment, any contract to the contrary not-
12 withstanding. Any person who violates this section shall
13 be fined not more than \$1,000.
