Mr. MCINTYRE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of the estate of William R. Holden and the
estate of John Davis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT AUTHORIZED.**

4 As soon as practicable after the date of the enactment
5 of this Act, the Secretary of the Army shall pay—

6 (1) to the estate of William R. Holden, social
7 security account number 267-02-9232, a lump sum
8 of \$1,000,000; and

1 (2) to the estate of John Davis, social security
2 account number 467-21-1729, a lump sum of
3 \$1,000,000.

4 **SEC. 2. FULL SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.**

5 (a) The payment authorized by paragraph (1) of sec-
6 tion 1 shall be in full satisfaction of all claims in connec-
7 tion with the incident which resulted in the death of Wil-
8 liam R. Holden and John Davis against the United States
9 of each of the following:

10 (1) The estate of William R. Holden.

11 (2) Judy Holden, widow of William R. Holden.

12 (3) The heirs and assigns of William R.
13 Holden.

14 (4) The heirs and assigns of Judy Holden.

15 (b) The payment authorized by paragraph (2) of sec-
16 tion 1 shall be in full satisfaction of all claims in connec-
17 tion with the incident which resulted in the death of Wil-
18 liam R. Holden and John Davis against the United States
19 of each of the following:

20 (1) The estate of John Davis.

21 (2) Teresa Davis, widow of John Davis.

22 (3) The heirs and assigns of John Davis.

23 (4) The heirs and assigns of Teresa Davis.

1 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON FEES.**

2 Not more than a total of 10 percent of the payment
3 authorized by paragraph (1) of section 1 and not more
4 than a total of 10 percent of the payment authorized by
5 paragraph (2) of section 1 shall be paid to or received by
6 agents or attorneys for services rendered in connection
7 with obtaining such payment, any contract to the contrary
8 notwithstanding. Any person who violates this section
9 shall be fined not more than \$1,000.
