AN ACT

To amend part Q of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to encourage the use of school resource officers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS.

2	Part Q of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and
3	Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796dd et seq.) is
4	amended—
5	(1) in section 1701(d)—
6	(A) by redesignating paragraphs (8)
7	through (10) as paragraphs (9) through (11),
8	respectively; and
9	(B) by inserting after paragraph (7) the
10	following:
11	"(8) establish school-based partnerships be-
12	tween local law enforcement agencies and local
13	school systems by using school resource officers who
14	operate in and around elementary and secondary
15	schools to combat school-related crime and disorder
16	problems, gangs, and drug activities;"; and
17	(2) in section 1709—
18	(A) by redesignating the first 3 undesig-
19	nated paragraphs as paragraphs (1) through
20	(3), respectively; and
21	(B) by adding at the end the following:
22	"(4) 'school resource officer' means a career
23	law enforcement officer, with sworn authority, de-
24	ployed in community-oriented policing, and assigned
25	by the employing police department or agency to

1	work in collaboration with schools and community-
2	based organizations—
3	"(A) to address crime and disorder prob-
4	lems, gangs, and drug activities affecting or oc-
5	curring in or around an elementary or second-
6	ary school;
7	"(B) to develop or expand crime prevention
8	efforts for students;
9	"(C) to educate likely school-age victims in
10	crime prevention and safety;
11	"(D) to develop or expand community jus-
12	tice initiatives for students;
13	"(E) to train students in conflict resolu-
14	tion, restorative justice, and crime awareness;
15	"(F) to assist in the identification of phys-
16	ical changes in the environment that may re-
17	duce crime in or around the school; and
18	"(G) to assist in developing school policy
19	that addresses crime and to recommend proce-
20	dural changes.".
