A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to complete a land exchange with Georgia Power Company.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. LAKE OCONEE LAND EXCHANGE, GEORGIA.

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARY.—The
6 term "description of the boundary" means the docu7 ments entitled "Description of the Boundary" dated
8 September 6, 1996, prepared by the Forest Service
9 and on file with the Secretary.

1	(2) EXCHANGE AGREEMENT.—The term "ex-
2	change agreement" means the agreement between
3	Georgia Power Company and the Forest Service
4	dated December 26, 1996, as amended on August
5	17, 1998, which is on file with the Secretary.
6	(3) Georgia power company.—The term
7	"Georgia Power Company" means Georgia Power
8	Company, a division of the Southern Company, a
9	Georgia corporation, or its successors or assigns.
10	(4) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
11	the Secretary of Agriculture.
12	(b) Land Exchange.—
13	(1) IN GENERAL.—Simultaneously with the con-
14	veyance by Georgia Power Company to the Secretary
15	of all right, title, and interest in and to the land de-
16	scribed in paragraph (2), the Secretary shall—
17	(A) convey to Georgia Power Company all
18	right, title, and interest in and to the land de-
19	scribed in paragraph (3), except as provided in
20	the exchange agreement; and
21	(B) make a value equalization payment of
22	\$23,250 to Georgia Power Company.
23	(2) LAND TO BE CONVEYED TO THE SEC-
24	RETARY.—The land described in this paragraph is
25	the land within or near the Chattahoochee National

Forest and Oconee National Forest in the State of
 Georgia, comprising approximately 1,175.46 acres,
 described in the exchange agreement and the de scription of the boundary.

5 (3) LAND TO BE CONVEYED TO GEORGIA
6 POWER COMPANY.—The land described in this para7 graph is the land in the State of Georgia, comprising
8 approximately 1,275.80 acres, described in the ex9 change agreement and the description of the bound10 ary.

11 (c) Partial Revocation of Withdrawals.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—The orders issued by the
Federal Energy Regulatory Commission under section 24 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 818),
authorizing Power Project Numbers 2413 and 2354,
issued August 6, 1969, and October 1, 1996, respectively, are revoked insofar as the orders affect the
land described in subsection (b)(3).

19 (2) NO ANNUAL CHARGE.—No interest con20 veyed to Georgia Power Company or easement right
21 retained by Georgia Power Company under this sec22 tion shall be subject to an annual charge for the
23 purpose of compensating the United States for the
24 use of its land for power purposes.

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
