AN ACT

For the relief of Nancy B. Wilson.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ENTITLEMENT TO WIDOW'S INSURANCE BENE-**
2 **FITS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—For purposes of determining the
4 eligibility of Nancy B. Wilson, the wife of Alphonse M.
5 Wilson (Social Security No. 271–18–9548), to widow's in-
6 surance benefits under section 202(e) of the Social Secu-
7 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(e)), Nancy B. Wilson shall be
8 deemed to have been married to Alphonse M. Wilson for
9 a period of not less than 9 months immediately prior to
10 the day on which Alphonse M. Wilson died.

11 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Subsection (a) takes effect
12 on March 21, 1991.

13 (c) **PAYMENT.**—Any benefits to which Nancy B. Wil-
14 son is entitled for the period prior to the date of the enact-
15 ment of this Act shall be paid to her in a lump sum.
