A BILL

For the relief of Nancy B. Wilson.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENTITLEMENT TO WIDOW'S INSURANCE BENE-**
4 **FITS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of determining the
6 eligibility of Nancy B. Wilson, the wife of Alphonse M.
7 Wilson (social security number 000–00–9548), to widow's
8 insurance benefits under section 202(e) of the Social Secu-
9 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 402(e)), Nancy B. Wilson shall be
10 deemed to have been married to Alphonse M. Wilson for
11 a period of not less than 9 months immediately prior to
12 the day on which Alphonse M. Wilson died.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall take ef-
2 fect on March 21, 1991.

3 (c) PAYMENT.—Any benefits to which Nancy B. Wil-
4 son is entitled for the period prior to the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act shall be paid to her in a lump sum.
