## A BILL

For the relief of Paul Green.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING APPLICATION
4	FOR CHILD'S INSURANCE BENEFIT AND
5	LUMP-SUM DEATH BENEFIT UNDER TITLE II
6	OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT.
7	If an application for a child's insurance benefit under
8	section 202(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
9	402(d)) is filed by or on behalf of Paul Green of Walnut
10	Street in Newton, Massachusetts, during the 1-year period
11	following the date of the enactment of this Act—

(1) the application shall be deemed, for purposes of section 202(d) of such Act, to have been filed during the month in which his mother, Marie Pendola Grardina (social security account number 000-00-2579), died; and

(2) the application shall be deemed to be an application for a lump-sum death benefit under section 202(i) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 402(i)), and for purposes of such section 202(i), to have been filed in the month during which his mother, Marie Pendola Grardina, died.
