A BILL

To ensure that pre-apprenticeship programs are considered when planning health professions opportunity grant career pathway demonstration projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pre-apprenticeship
5 Promotion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS REQUIRED TO**
2 **BE CONSIDERED IN PLANNING HEALTH PRO-**
3 **FESIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT CAREER**
4 **PATHWAY DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS.**

5 Section 2008 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
6 1397g) is amended by redesignating subsections (c) and
7 (d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively, and by insert-
8 ing after subsection (b) the following:

9 “(c) PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS REQUIRED
10 TO BE CONSIDERED IN PLANNING DEMONSTRATION
11 PROJECTS.—An application for a grant for a demonstra-
12 tion project under this section shall include a certification
13 by the applicant that the development of the project in-
14 cluded consideration of apprenticeship and pre-apprentice-
15 ship models registered under the Act of August 16, 1937
16 (also known as the ‘National Apprenticeship Act’).”.

17 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

18 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
19 on October 1, 2019.
