CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Calling on the President to sign H.R. 2 of the 118th Congress, the Secure the Border Act of 2023.

Whereas it is the opinion of Congress that the deadly and humanitarian crisis at our border is an invasion of historic proportions;

Whereas millions of illegal immigrants have crossed our southern border, flooding our communities and our cities; and

Whereas this invasion is one that was avoidable and, in the opinion of Congress, directly caused by the actions started on day one of President Biden's Administration to

weaken our border security and national security for political purposes: Now, therefore, be it

3 H.R. 2 of the 118th Congress, the Secure the Border Act
4 of 2023, following its necessary passage in the Senate.
