2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Promoting Program-
5 ming, Research, Education and Preservation in Civics and
6 Government Act” or the “PREP Civics and Government
7 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CIVICS AND GOVERNMENT INCLUDED IN HUMAN-**
2 **ITIES.**

3 Section 3(a) of the National Foundation on the Arts
4 and the Humanities Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 952(a)) is
5 amended by inserting “civics and government;” after “his-
6 tory;”.
