1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF MASK MANDATE TO PREVENT**
4 **THE SPREAD OF COVID–19 ON A MILITARY IN-**
5 **STALLATION IN THE UNITED STATES.**

6 The Secretary of Defense may not require that an
7 individual wear a mask, in order to prevent the spread

1 of COVID-19, on a military installation inside the United
2 States.
