To direct the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency to consider nuclear power to be a green source of energy, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF NUCLEAR POWER AS A GREEN**
4 **SOURCE OF ENERGY UNDER THE GREEN**
5 **POWER PARTNERSHIP.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out the Green Power
7 Partnership, the Administrator of the Environmental Pro-
8 tection Agency shall consider nuclear power to be a green
9 source of energy for purposes of determining whether a

1 participant meets the minimum electricity use requirement
2 of the Green Power Partnership.

3 (b) USE OF FUNDS.—No Federal funds may be made
4 available to carry out the Green Power Partnership unless
5 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-
6 cy includes nuclear power as a green source of energy as
7 required under subsection (a).
