A BILL

To develop and disseminate a civic education curriculum and oral history resources regarding certain political ideologies, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Crucial Communism*
5 *Teaching Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSES.**

7 *The purposes of this Act are the following:*

8 (1) *To help families, civic institutions, local*
9 *communities, local educational agencies, high schools,*
10 *and State educational agencies to prepare high school*
11 *students to be civically responsible and knowledgeable*
12 *adults.*

13 (2) *To ensure that high school students in the*
14 *United States—*

15 (A) *learn that communism has led to the*
16 *deaths of over 100,000,000 victims worldwide;*

17 (B) *understand the dangers of communism*
18 *and similar political ideologies; and*

19 (C) *understand that 1,500,000,000 people*
20 *still suffer under communism.*

21 **SEC. 3. DEVELOPMENT AND DISSEMINATION OF CIVIC EDU-**
22 **CATION CURRICULUM AND ORAL HISTORY**
23 **RESOURCES.**

24 *The independent entity created under section*
25 *905(b)(1)(B) of the FRIENDSHIP Act (40 U.S.C. 8903*

1 note; 107 Stat. 2331 note), also known as the “Victims of
2 Communism Memorial Foundation”, shall—

3 (1) develop a civic education curriculum for high
4 school students that—

5 (A) includes a comparative discussion of
6 certain political ideologies, including com-
7 munism and totalitarianism, that conflict with
8 the principles of freedom and democracy that are
9 essential to the founding of the United States;

10 (B) is accurate, relevant, and accessible, so
11 as to promote the understanding of such political
12 ideologies; and

13 (C) is compatible with a variety of courses,
14 including social studies, government, history,
15 and economics classes;

16 (2) develop oral history resources that may be
17 used alongside the curriculum described in paragraph
18 (1) and that include personal stories, titled “Portraits
19 in Patriotism”, from diverse individuals who—

20 (A) demonstrate civic-minded qualities;

21 (B) are victims of the political ideologies
22 described in paragraph (1)(A); and

23 (C) are able to compare the political
24 ideologies described in paragraph (1)(A) with the
25 political ideology of the United States; and

1 (3) engage with State and local educational lead-
2 ers to assist high schools in using the curriculum de-
3 scribed in paragraph (1) and the resources described
4 in paragraph (2).

5 **SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.**

6 The terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Sec-
7 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801) shall apply
8 to this Act.

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
