## A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to clarify the limitations period during which an action may be commenced for judicial review of a final rule.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Timely Initiation to  
5 Modify Executive Rulemaking Act” or the “TIMER Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS.**

7 Section 2401 of title 28, United States Code, is  
8 amended—

1           (1) in subsection (a), by inserting after “chap-  
2           ter 71 of title 41” the following: “and subject to  
3           subsection (b)”;

4           (2) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-  
5           section (c); and

6           (3) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
7           lowing:

8           “(b) A civil action commenced against the United  
9           States under chapter 7 of title 5, United States Code, for  
10          judicial review of a final rule shall be barred unless the  
11          complaint is filed within six years after the date on which  
12          the final rule is issued.”.
