## A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to abolish the reorganization authority of the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ABOLITION OF REORGANIZATION AUTHORITY**  
4 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECUR-**  
5 **RITY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title VIII of the Homeland Secu-  
7 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 361 et seq.) is amended—

8 (1) by striking section 857 (6 U.S.C. 427);

9 (2) by redesignating section 858 (6 U.S.C. 428)

10 as section 857;

1           (3) by striking section 872 (6 U.S.C. 452); and  
2           (4) by striking section 881 (6 U.S.C. 461).

3           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The Homeland  
4 Security Act of 2002 is amended—

5           (1) in section 506 (6 U.S.C. 316)—

6                 (A) by striking subsection (b); and

7                 (B) by redesignating subsections (c) and  
8           (d) as subsections (b) and (c), respectively; and

9           (2) in section 702(b) (6 U.S.C. 342(b)), by  
10 striking paragraph (4).

11          (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The table of contents  
12 in section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is  
13 amended—

14           (1) by striking the items relating to sections  
15       857 and 858 and inserting the following new item:

“Sec. 857. Identification of new entrants into the Federal marketplace.”; and

16           (2) by striking the items relating to sections  
17       872 and 881.
