A BILL

To require responsiveness testing of Defense Logistics Agency pharmaceutical contracts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Further Strengthening
5 Supply Chains for Servicemembers and Security Act of
6 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESPONSIVENESS TESTING OF DEFENSE LOGISTICS**
2 **AGENCY PHARMACEUTICAL CONTRACTS.**

3 The Director of the Defense Logistics Agency shall
4 modify Defense Logistics Agency Instructions 5025.03
5 and 3110.01—

6 (1) to require Defense Logistics Agency Troop
7 Support to coordinate annually with customers in
8 the military departments to conduct responsiveness
9 testing of the Defense Logistics Agency's contin-
10 gency contracts for pharmaceuticals; and

11 (2) to include the results of that testing, as re-
12 ported by customers in the military departments, in
13 the annual reports of the Warstopper Program.

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
