- To amend title 49, United States Code, to allow the Secretary of Transportation to designate an authorized operator of the commercial driver's license information system, and for other purposes.

#### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 2 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthening the 3 Commercial Driver's License Information System Act". SEC. 2. 9	in accordance with subsection (e); and
10	"(3) to use any fees collected in accordance
11	with that subsection.
12	"(e) Fee System.—
13	"(1) In general.—The Secretary or the au-
14	thorized operator, as applicable, may charge a rea-
15	sonable fee for use of the information system.
16	"(2) Amount of fees.—The total amount of
17	fees collected under this subsection shall equal, as
18	nearly as possible, the total amount necessary for
19	the purposes and uses described in paragraph
20	(3)(B).
21	"(3) Use of fees.—Fees collected under this
22	subsection shall—
23	"(A) be credited to—
24	"(i) an appropriation account; or

1	"(ii) an account designated by the au					
2	thorized operator; and					
3	"(B) be available only for the purposes of					
4	operating, maintaining, developing, modern-					
5	izing, or enhancing, or any other use relating					
6	to, the information system, including for per					
7	sonnel and administration costs relating to the					
8	information system.					
9	"(4) Availability of amounts.—Fees col-					
10	lected under this subsection shall remain available					
11	until expended for a purpose or use described in					
12	paragraph (3)(B).					
13	"(5) AUTHORIZED OPERATOR.—If the Sec-					
14	retary designates an authorized operator under sub-					
15	section (d)—					
16	"(A) the Secretary shall not be charged a					
17	fee for access to, use of, or data in the informa-					
18	tion system; and					
19	"(B) the Secretary shall have access to fee					
20	statements on a quarterly basis.".					
21	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section					
22	31311(a)(21) of title 49, United States Code, is amended					
23	by striking "By the date established by the Secretary					

- 1 under section 31309(e)(4), the State shall be operating"
- 2 and inserting "The State shall operate".
