A BILL

To require a report by the Secretary of Homeland Security regarding the failed assassination attempt on the life of Donald J. Trump in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REPORT REGARDING FAILED ASSASSINATION**
 2 **ATTEMPT ON THE LIFE OF DONALD J.**
 3 **TRUMP.**

4 Not later than 7 days after the date of enactment
 5 of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall sub-
 6 mit a report that contains any and all information in the
 7 possession of the Department of Homeland Security or
 8 any of its components, including the United States Secret
 9 Service, relating to the failed assassination attempt on the
 10 life of Donald J. Trump in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July
 11 13, 2024, to—

- 12 (1) the Committee on Homeland Security and
 13 Governmental Affairs of the Senate; and
 14 (2) the Committee on Oversight and Account-
 15 ability and the Committee on Homeland Security of
 16 the House of Representatives.

17 **SECTION 1. REPORT REGARDING FAILED ASSASSINATION**
 18 **ATTEMPTS ON THE LIFE OF DONALD J.**
 19 **TRUMP.**

20 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—Notwithstanding the information
 21 already provided by the Secretary of Homeland Security
 22 to the appropriate congressional committees, not later than
 23 7 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
 24 of Homeland Security, or a designee, shall submit to the
 25 appropriate congressional committees a report that con-
 26 tains any and all information in the possession of the De-

1 *partment of Homeland Security or any of its components,*
2 *including the United States Secret Service, relating to the*
3 *failed assassination attempts on the life of Donald J.*
4 *Trump in Butler, Pennsylvania, on July 13, 2024, and in*
5 *West Palm Beach, Florida, on September 15, 2024, includ-*
6 *ing—*

7 (1) *the motives, methods, and actions of the sus-*
8 *pects;*

9 (2) *requests for additional resources or protective*
10 *measures for Donald J. Trump or his campaign;*

11 (3) *preparations for the event in Butler, Penn-*
12 *sylvania, by the United States Secret Service and*
13 *other law enforcement entities; and*

14 (4) *responses by United States Secret Service*
15 *and other law enforcement entities to the attempted*
16 *assassinations.*

17 (b) *FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)*
18 *shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include*
19 *a classified annex.*

20 (c) *DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-*
21 *priate congressional committees” means—*

22 (1) *the Committee on Homeland Security and*
23 *Governmental Affairs and the Committee on the Judi-*
24 *ciary of the Senate; and*

1 (2) *the Committee on Homeland Security, the*
2 *Committee on the Judiciary, and the Task Force on*
3 *the Attempted Assassination of Donald J. Trump of*
4 *the House of Representatives.*

5 (d) *RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act*
6 *shall be construed to require that Congress enact legislation*
7 *to require the executive branch to expeditiously comply with*
8 *official requests for information made by a Member of the*
9 *Senate or House of Representatives, or the staff of such a*
10 *Member.*
