A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to sunset the Federal income tax on unemployment compensation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF TAX ON UNEMPLOYMENT**
4 **COMPENSATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 85 of the Internal Rev-
6 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking subsection (c)
7 and inserting the following new subsection:

8 “(c) TERMINATION OF INCLUSION IN GROSS IN-
9 COME.—This section shall not apply to taxable years be-
10 ginning after December 31, 2024.”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to amounts received after Decem-
3 ber 31, 2024, in taxable years ending after such date.

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
