SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides that the amendment to H.R. 4078 printed in section 2 of the resolution shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The amendment printed in section 2 of the resolution is as follows:

“In section 102(b), strike ‘employment’ and insert ‘unemployment’.”
