OkTex Pipeline Company; Notice of Proposed Changes in FERC Gas Tariff

August 11, 1998.

Take notice that on August 6, 1998, OkTex Pipeline Company (OkTex), filed revised tariff sheets in compliance with the Commission's directives in Order No. 587-G.

OkTex states that the tariff sheets reflect the changes to OkTex's tariff that result from the Gas Industry Standards Board's (GISB) consensus standards that were adopted by the Commission in its April 16, 1998 Order No. 587-G in Docket No. RM96-1-007. OkTex further states that the tariff sheets that are revised reflect discrepancies identified by the FERC in OkTex's June 30, 1998 filing.
