SUMMARY: On January 22, 2001, a notice inviting applications for new fiscal year (FY) 2001 awards under the Office of Special Education and Rehabilitative Services; Grant Applications under Part D, Subpart 2 of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act was published in the Federal Register (66 FR 6832).
