It addresses the problem of sexual assault (SA) in the military and the need for a rigorous evaluation of the USMC Pre-Command Sexual Assault Prevention and Response—Integrated Prevention (SAPR—IP) Training. SAPR—IP is an existing program implemented across the USMC for all slated Commanders and Sergeants Majors. The proposed program evaluation and data collection will assess the impact of the revised training program to create safe, stable, and supportive command environments free from sexual assault.
