August 20, 2024, the President issued a  
major disaster declaration under the  
authority of the Robert T. Stafford  
Disaster Relief and Emergency  
Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 5121 *et seq.*  
(the “Stafford Act”), as follows:

I have determined that the damage to the  
lands associated with the Santa Clara Pueblo  
resulting from severe storms and flooding  
during the period of June 20 to June 21, 2024,  
is of sufficient severity and magnitude to  
warrant a major disaster declaration under  
the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and  
Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 5121 *et seq.*  
(the “Stafford Act”). Therefore, I declare  
that such a major disaster exists for the Santa  
Clara Pueblo.

In order to provide Federal assistance, you  
are hereby authorized to allocate from funds  
available for these purposes such amounts as  
you find necessary for Federal disaster  
assistance and administrative expenses.

You are authorized to provide Public  
Assistance and Hazard Mitigation for the  
Santa Clara Pueblo. Consistent with the  
requirement that Federal assistance be  
supplemental, any Federal funds provided  
under the Stafford Act for Public Assistance  
and Hazard Mitigation will be limited to 75  
percent of the total eligible costs.

Further, you are authorized to make  
changes to this declaration for the approved

assistance to the extent allowable under the  
Stafford Act.

The Federal Emergency Management  
Agency (FEMA) hereby gives notice that  
pursuant to the authority vested in the  
Administrator, under Executive Order  
12148, as amended, James B.  
McPherson, of FEMA is appointed to act  
as the Federal Coordinating Officer for  
this major disaster.

The following areas have been  
designated as adversely affected by this  
major disaster:

Santa Clara Pueblo for Public Assistance.
