SIR: I have the honor to transmit herewith for the consideration of Congress a supplemental estimate of appropriation for the Children's Bureau, Department of Labor, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1926, amounting to \$10,000.

The details of this estimate, the necessity therefor, and the reason for its submission at this time are set forth in the letter of the Director of the Bureau of the Budget transmitted herewith, with whose comments and observations thereon I concur.

SIR: I have the honor to submit herewith for your consideration a supplemental estimate of appropriation for the Children's Bureau, Department of Labor, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1926, as follows:

Promotion of the welfare and hygiene of maternity and infancy, Children's Bureau----- \$10,000

The appropriation for 1926 provided \$50,354 for administering the act and \$949,646 for "grants to States." The estimate of \$949,646 as the probable amount necessary for allotment to States was based upon the best information available when the estimate for the fiscal year 1926 was submitted.

Additional States have since complied with the conditions necessary to receive allotments from the fund, and \$10,000 additional is required to comply with the provisions of the act approved November 23, 1921, as amended.

The above estimate of appropriation is required to meet a contingency which has arisen since the Budget for 1926 was transmitted, and its approval is recommended.
