ORDER

Defendant was indicted on September 14, 2022 (Doc. 1) and arraigned on November 28, 2022. Doc. 23. A pretrial conference is currently scheduled for December 20, 2022. Doc. 26. The parties jointly ask to continue the case to the March 2023 trial term. Specifically, Defendant needs additional time to review discovery, to discuss discovery and possible defenses with counsel, conduct additional investigation, and to discuss a possible universal resolution. Additionally, the Defendant's co-defendants have not yet been arrested.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-referenced matter be continued to next term of Court set for March 2023, and that the Speedy Trial deadline for the trial in this matter imposed by 18 U.S.C. § 3161(c)(1) be extended to that time. The Court finds that the ends of justice served by granting of this continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the Defendant in a speedy trial because a failure to grant such continuance could result in a miscarriage of justice and would deny counsel for the Defendant and Government the reasonable time necessary for effective preparation. 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(6), (7)(A)-(B). The delay occasioned by this continuance shall not be considered

in calculating the speedy trial deadline under the Speedy Trial Act.
