ORDER

The Court received Petitioner’s application for habeas corpus relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 and motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”) on October 11, 2024 (ECF Nos. 1, 2). Because Petitioner has established that he is unable to pay the \$5.00 filing fee, his motion to proceed IFP (ECF No. 2) is **GRANTED**. Having initially reviewed Petitioner’s application, the Court finds good cause to extend the time for a response. 28 U.S.C. § 2243. Accordingly, Respondent shall have twenty-one (21) days to file a comprehensive response to said application. Within fourteen (14) days thereafter, Petitioner should file any desired reply. The Court will consider whether to hold an evidentiary hearing once briefing is complete.
