**ORDER DISMISSING  
DEFENDANT SALLI  
BOLTHOUSE**

The defendant Salli Bolthouse filed a motion to dismiss on July 31, 2014. The Clerk's Office sent a Notice to the pro se plaintiff explaining that a consequence of his failure to respond.
