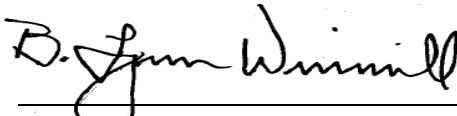
IT IS ORDERED:

2. Plaintiffs shall immediately file their third amended complaint.

3. The following deadlines will be extended as noted:
- a. Dispositive Motion Deadline: **April 25, 2015.**
 - b. Amendment of Pleadings and Joinder of Parties: **November 16, 2015.**
 - c. Alternative Dispute Resolution Plan: **May 9, 2015.**
 - d. Completion of Discovery: **February 29, 2016.**
 - e. Disclosure of Experts:
 - i. Plaintiffs: **November 9, 2015.**
 - ii. Defendants: **December 21, 2015.**
 - iii. Rebuttal: **January 18, 2016.**
