A BILL

To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 120 12th Street in Columbus, Georgia, as the “J. Robert Elliott Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building and United States courthouse
5 located at 120 12th Street in Columbus, Georgia, shall
6 be known and designated as the “J. Robert Elliott Federal
7 Building and United States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building and United States courthouse referred to in sec-
5 tion 1 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “J. Robert
6 Elliott Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.
