Mr. EDWARDS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of land at Fort Hood, Texas, to facilitate the establishment of a State-run cemetery for veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Field of Honor Act
5 of 2002”.

6 **SEC. 2. LAND CONVEYANCE, FORT HOOD, TEXAS.**

7 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
8 the Army may convey, without consideration, to the Vet-
9 erans Land Board of the State of Texas (in this section
10 referred to as the “Board”), all right, title, and interest

1 of the United States in and to a parcel of real property,
2 including any improvements thereon, consisting of ap-
3 proximately 174 acres at Fort Hood, Texas, for the pur-
4 pose of permitting the Board to establish a State-run cem-
5 etery for veterans.

6 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
7 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
8 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
9 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
10 borne by the Board.

11 (c) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
12 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
13 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
14 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
15 interests of the United States.
