A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Acid Black 132 and Acid Black 172.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACID BLACK 132 AND ACID BLACK 172.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new headings:

“	9902.32.02	Chromate(3-), bis[3-(hydroxy-kO)-4-[[2-(hydroxy-kO)-1-naphthalenyl]azokN1]-7-nitro-1-naphthalenesulfonato(3-)]-, tri-sodium (CAS No. 57693-14-8) (provided for in subheading 3204.12.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
