To codify the duty-free treatment of imports of straight sawn shingles of western red cedar.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CODIFICATION OF DUTY-FREE TREATMENT OF**
4 **STRAIGHT SAWN SHINGLES OF WESTERN**
5 **RED CEDAR.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 4418 of the Harmonized
7 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by strik-
8 ing subheading 4418.50.00 and inserting the following
9 new subheadings and superior text thereto, with such su-

1 perior text having the same degree of indentation as the
 2 article description for subheading 4418.40.00:

“	4418.50.10	Shingles and shakes: Straight sawn shingles of western red cedar of a length of 25 inches or less, of a random width of three to 14 inches (edges parallel within one-half inch), and of a thickness of one-quarter to one and one-half inches (with or without taper)	Free	Free	”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
 5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 6 April 1, 2002.
