**A BILL**

To authorize leases for terms not to exceed 99 years on lands held in trust for the Yurok Tribe and the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. YUOK TRIBE AND HOPLAND BAND INCLUDED**  
2 **IN LONG TERM LEASING.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The first section of the Act enti-  
4 tled “An Act to authorize the leasing of restricted Indian  
5 lands for public, religious, educational, recreational, resi-  
6 dential, business, and other purposes requiring the grant  
7 of long-term leases”, approved August 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C.  
8 415(a)) is amended by inserting “lands held in trust for  
9 the Yurok Tribe, lands held in trust for the Hopland Band  
10 of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Rancheria,” after “Pueb-  
11 lo of Santa Clara,”.

12 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
13 subsection (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or re-  
14 newed after the date of the enactment of this Act.
