To amend the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 to exclude monthly Social Security survivor benefits and Social Security lump sum death benefit as collateral sources.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “September 11th Victim
5 Compensation Fund Family Benefits Fairness Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COLLATERAL SOURCE EXEMPTION.**

7 Paragraph (6) of section 402 of the September 11th
8 Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 (49 U.S.C. 40101

1 note) is amended by adding at the end the following: “The
2 term does not include benefits under subsection (d), (e),
3 (f), (g), (h), or (i) of section 202 of the Social Security
4 Act (42 U.S.C. 402) based on the wages and self-employ-
5 ment income of an individual who died as a result of such
6 crashes.”.
