A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Commerce to establish and appoint the members of a Marine Protected Areas Advisory Committee in accordance with a Department of Commerce document.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO ESTABLISH A MARINE PRO-**
2 **TECTED AREAS ADVISORY COMMITTEE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 6 months after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Com-
5 merce shall establish and appoint the members of a Ma-
6 rine Protected Areas Advisory Committee in accordance
7 with the Department of Commerce document entitled
8 “MPA Advisory Committee Supplement 1. Charter of the
9 MPA Federal Advisory Committee, December 18, 2000”.

10 (b) OBJECTIVE, DUTIES, POWERS, AND OPER-
11 ATION.—The advisory committee shall have the objective,
12 duties, and powers as set forth in the document referred
13 to in subsection (a), and shall meet and otherwise operate
14 in accordance with that document.

15 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—To carry
16 out this section, including for administrative expenses of
17 the advisory committee established under this section,
18 there is authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary
19 \$750,000 for each fiscal year.
