Mrs. THURMAN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1862) to amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to provide greater access to affordable pharmaceuticals.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1862) to amend the Federal Food,
6 Drug, and Cosmetic Act to provide greater access to af-
7 fordable pharmaceuticals. The first reading of the bill
8 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
9 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-

1 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
2 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
3 ity member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce.
4 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
5 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be
6 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of
7 the Whole shall accord priority in recognition to Rep-
8 resentative Brown of Ohio to offer an amendment. At the
9 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
10 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
11 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
13 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
14 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
15 structions.

16 SEC. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
17 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
18 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
19 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
20 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
21 ther consideration of the bill.
