3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 Section 10 of Public Law 99–647 (16 U.S.C. 461
5 note) is amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting
6 the following:

7 “(b) DEVELOPMENT FUNDS.—There is authorized to
8 be appropriated to carry out section 8(e) for the period

1 of fiscal years 2003 through 2006 not more than
2 \$10,000,000, to remain available until expended.”.
