3 **SECTION 1. 1,3-BENZENEDICARBOXAMIDE, N, N'-BIS (2,2,6,6-**
4 **TETRAMETHYL-4-PIPERIDINYL)-.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
