3 **SECTION 1. HYDRATED HYDROXYPROPYL**
4 **METHYLCELLULOSE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.98.09	Hydrated hydroxypropyl methylcellulose; cellulose, 2-hydroxypropyl methyl ether; cellulose; hydroxylpropyl methyl ether (CAS No. 9004-65-3) (provided in subheading 3912.39.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
