AN ACT

To extend for one year procedural relief provided under the USA PATRIOT Act for individuals who were or are victims or survivors of victims of a terrorist attack on the United States on September 11, 2001.

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF PERIOD OF LAWFUL PRESENCE**
2 **IN THE UNITED STATES FOR CERTAIN ALIEN**
3 **VICTIMS OF TERRORIST ATTACK ON UNITED**
4 **STATES ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2001.**

5 Section 422(a)(1)(B) of the Uniting and Strength-
6 ening America by Providing Appropriate Tools Required
7 to Intercept and Obstruct Terrorism (USA PATRIOT
8 ACT) Act of 2001 (Public Law 107–56; 115 Stat. 357)
9 is amended by striking “1 year” and inserting “2 years”.
