## A BILL

To provide that certain ceiling fans enter duty-free and without any quantitative limitations if the competitive need limitation had been waived with respect to the fans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CEILING FANS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
5 sion of law, ceiling fans classified under subheading  
6 8414.51.00 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
7 United States imported from Thailand shall enter duty-  
8 free and without any quantitative limitations, if duty-free  
9 treatment under title V of the Trade Act of 1974 (19

1 U.S.C. 2461 et seq.) would have applied to such entry had  
2 the competitive need limitation been waived under section  
3 503(d) of such Act.

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The provisions of this section  
5 shall apply to ceiling fans described in subsection (a) that  
6 are entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for  
7 consumption—

8 (1) on or after the date that is 15 days after  
9 the date of enactment of this Act; and

10 (2) before July 30, 2003.
