2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF MICHAEL LEE WOODCOCK**
4 **POST OFFICE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 206 South Main Street in
7 Glennville, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the
8 “Michael Lee Woodcock Post Office”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Michael Lee Woodcock
5 Post Office.
