## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Disapproving of the participation of the United States in the provision by the International Monetary Fund of a multibillion dollar funding package for the European Union, until the member states of the European Union comply with the economic requirements of membership in the European Union.

2 *concurring)*, That the Congress disapproves of the partici-  
3 pation of the United States in the provision by the Inter-  
4 national Monetary Fund of a multibillion dollar funding  
5 package to the European Union, until each member state  
6 of the European Union demonstrate compliance with the

1 economic requirements of membership in the European  
2 Union, including limiting the deficit of the member state  
3 to 3 percent of the gross domestic product of the member  
4 state and limiting the total public debt of the member  
5 state to 60 percent of the gross domestic product of the  
6 member state.
