## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that the United Nations or NATO should investigate the treatment of black Africans in Libya.

3 retary of State should direct the permanent representative  
4 of the United States to the North Atlantic Treaty Organi-  
5 zation (NATO) and the permanent representative of the  
6 United States to the United Nations to request that  
7 NATO and the United Nations, respectively, investigate  
8 the treatment of black Africans in Libya.
