## A BILL

To prohibit the hiring of additional employees by the Internal Revenue Service to implement, administer, or enforce health insurance reform.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Keep Out the IRS Act  
5 of 2011”.

6       **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON HIRING ADDITIONAL IRS EMPLOY-**  
7                               **EES TO IMPLEMENT, ADMINISTER, OR EN-**  
8                               **FORCE HEALTH INSURANCE REFORM.**

9       No position within the Internal Revenue Service may  
10 be filled, by transfer or any other appointment taking ef-

1   fect on or after the date of enactment of this Act, if the  
2   duties and responsibilities of such position include the im-  
3   plementation, administration, or enforcement of any provi-  
4   sion of, or amendment made by, the Patient Protection  
5   and Affordable Care Act or the Health Care and Edu-  
6   cation Reconciliation Act of 2010.
