## A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to provide that greenhouse gases are not subject to the Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Energy Production  
5 Freedom Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GREENHOUSE GAS REGULATION UNDER CLEAN AIR**

7 **ACT.**

8 Section 302(g) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.  
9 7602(g)) is amended by adding the following at the end  
10 thereof: “The term ‘air pollutant’ shall not include carbon

1 dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, hydrofluorocarbons,  
2 perfluorocarbons, or sulfur hexafluoride.”.

3 **SEC. 3. CLIMATE CHANGE NOT REGULATED BY CLEAN AIR**  
4 **ACT.**

5 Nothing in the Clean Air Act shall be treated as au-  
6 thorizing or requiring the regulation of climate change or  
7 global warming.
