A BILL

To provide for an audit of all gold owned by the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gold Reserve Trans-
- 5 parency Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. ASSAY, INVENTORY, AND AUDIT OF GOLD RE-
- 7 SERVES.
- 8 (a) The Secretary of the Treasury is directed to con-
- 9 duct and complete, not later than six months after the
- 10 date of enactment of this Act, a full assay, inventory, and
- 11 audit of gold reserves of the United States at the place

- 1 or places where such reserves are kept, together with an
- 2 analysis of the sufficiency of the measures taken for the
- 3 security of such reserves.
- 4 (b)(1) The Government Accountability Office shall re-
- 5 view the results of such assay, inventory, audit, and anal-
- 6 ysis and, not later than nine months after the date of en-
- 7 actment of this Act, shall prepare and transmit to the
- 8 Congress a report of its findings, together with the results
- 9 of the assay, inventory, audit, and analysis conducted by
- 10 the Secretary of the Treasury.
- 11 (2) For purposes of such assay, inventory, audit, and
- 12 analysis, the Government Accountability Office shall have
- 13 access to any depository or other facility where such re-
- 14 serves are kept.
- (c) The Secretary of the Treasury shall make avail-
- 16 able, in order to facilitate the review of the Government
- 17 Accountability Office under this Act, all books, accounts,
- 18 records, reports, files, correspondence, memoranda, pa-
- 19 pers, or any other document, tape, or written, audio, or
- 20 digital record pertaining to the assay, inventory, audit,
- 21 and analysis required by this Act, as determined by the
- 22 Government Accountability Office.
