A BILL

To amend title VI of the Clean Air Act to make a restriction on the use of class II substances inapplicable to certain fire suppression agents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fire Protection Act
5 of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. FIRE SUPPRESSION AGENTS.**

7 Section 605(a) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
8 7671d(a)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “or” at the end of paragraph
2 (2);

3 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
4 graph (3) and inserting “; or”; and

5 (3) by adding the following new paragraph after
6 paragraph (3):

7 “(4) is listed as acceptable for use as a fire sup-
8 pression agent for nonresidential applications in ac-
9 cordance with section 612(c).”.
